

# Call for Papers- Emerging India

JIOR is making a call for papers for a special issue focusing primarily on India, its growing role in the region and how it is influencing changing dynamics in the region. The issue is planned for publication in December 2016.

## Themes of particular interest include:

### **New Regionalism:**

Emergence of India in Asia and Pacific region; 'Trade East' Policy of India; India and regional leadership; economics of India-Asia trade and investment; economic and mega-regionalism; changing geography and political alignment in Indian Ocean

### **India's role in the Indian Ocean:**

Economic issues focusing in particular on trade and non-trade issues; investment and labour; relationship with countries in Indian Ocean

### **Human security issues and inequality:**

Cross border refugees; internal, regional, and transnational population displacement and migration; labour issues; poverty; gender issues

### **Agriculture, Environment and Development:**

Indian agriculture; food security; land grabs; environmental issues; governance; climate change

### **Security issues:**

Role of armed forces in Indian Ocean; piracy; terrorism; relations with immediate neighbours; other matters of geostrategic interest

We particularly welcome papers addressing these questions from diverse disciplinary and methodological approaches.
