Following an ESRC grant award entitled 'Transformations in Global Governance: Integration via Free Trade Agreements', a series of workshops are being organised that focus on:

- Regulatory, economic and social aspects of regional integration through free trade agreement (FTAs)
- Effects of FTAs with and in partner countries
- The current state of play in FTA activity in the EU, USA and Asia

The fourth workshop will be held in Bath on 28-29 January 2016. The event will primarily focus on various facets of the **Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP)** between the EU and USA, such as:

- Role of TTIP in the US and EU broader foreign policies
- Regulatory effects of TTIP
- Potential economic and social consequences of TTIP
- TTIP negotiation dynamics
- Implications of TTIP for other partners

We particularly welcome paper proposals addressing these questions from diverse disciplinary approaches (Economics, Politics and Law) and methodological positions.
