Following an ESRC grant award entitled 'Transformations in Global Governance: Integration via Free Trade Agreements', a series of workshops are being organized that focus on:

- Regulatory, economic and social aspects of regional integration through free trade agreement (FTAs)
- Effects of FTAs with and in partner countries
- The current state of play in FTA activity in the EU, USA and Asia

A seminar/workshop will be held in London on 5 December 2016. The event will primarily focus on various facets of global dynamics of free trade agreements, including:

- Interactions between trade agreements and the multilateral trading system
- Power relations and asymmetries in trade agreements

We particularly welcome paper proposals addressing these questions from diverse disciplinary approaches (Economics, Politics and Law) and methodological positions.
